

WE ARE MOVING TO RIYADH

We are delighted to announce that Stone & Surface Saudi will be moving to Riyadh for its 2020 edition. After its successful three years in Jeddah, and lengthy discussions with the industry regarding the need for a focused event in Riyadh, we have responded and will bring Stone & Surface Saudi to Riyadh International Convention & Exhibition Center (RICEC) from 11 – 13 February 2020, co-located with FM Expo Saudi and HVAC R Expo Saudi.

THE RED SEA PROJECT

Phase 1 of the scheme is due to complete in 2022 and includes 14 luxury and hyper-luxury hotels that will comprise 3,000 rooms, all across five islands and two inland resorts.

RIYADH



QIDDIYA

Located 40km from Riyadh, Qiddiya will be more than twice the size of Walt Disney World Orlando in Florida, US, and will feature a Six Flags-branded theme park, hotels, and amusement and leisure facilities.

ESTIMATED PROJECT VALUE: USD 4 Billion ESTIMATED COMPLETION DATE: 2022



RIYADH METRO

The Riyadh Metro is a rapid transit system under construction in the city of Riyadh, the capital of Saudi Arabia. It will consist of six metro lines spanning a total length of 176 kilometres, with 85 stations.

ESTIMATED PROJECT VALUE: USD 23 Billion ESTIMATED COMPLETION DATE: Q2, 2021



DAHIYAT AL FURSAN

The project involves the construction of 100,000 houses and infrastructure works. The project will also include construction of apartments, townhouses, education buildings, commercial buildings, research & development centres.

ESTIMATED PROJECT VALUE: USD 20 Billion ESTIMATED COMPLETION DATE: Q2, 2020



THE AVENUES - AL MALQA

The project involves the construction of a 1.7 million sq mtrs shopping mall. The project will also include 2 residential towers, 2 hotel towers, a medical tower and office units.

ESTIMATED PROJECT VALUE: USD 1.9 Billion ESTIMATED COMPLETION DATE: Q2, 2020



Among the region's most closely watched supertalls currently under development, the 200-floor-plus tower will feature more than 750 residential units, hotel rooms, and serviced apartments, in addition to 3,190 parking spots and close to 60 elevators.

NEOM

The centrepiece of Saudi Arabia's gigaproject ecosystem and the Vision 2030 economic diversification programme, the

Neom is among the kingdom's most globally renowned projects at moment.



MALL OF SAUDI

The project involves the construction of a mall spread over an area of 866,000 sq mtrs including indoor snow parks and 300,000 sq mtrs of shops, restaurants, entertainment areas, residential hotels and serviced apartment buildings.






