




Value of GCC contract awards by country, 2016-2020 (\$m)






Breakdown of future Saudi projects by sector (\$m)



It will also comprise 7 different museums, golf course, equestrian centre, visitor centre, 12,000 residential units, 16 hotels and 500,000 square metres of retail space
