- The Ministry of Environment, Water and Agriculture of Saudi Arabia has approved \$80bn for 3,300 development projects in the water sector of which 2,000 have already secured funds.
- With most of Saudi's water supply coming from non-renewable groundwater, investment in desalination plants is underway with a plan for 100% private sector management by 2030. [ITA]
- With up to half of the country's land not yet connected to formal wastewater structures, a goal is in place to achieve 100 percent treated urban wastewater reuse by 2025. [SAWEA]
- Today, Saudi Arabia can store 2.2 days' worth of water in demand. By 2030, mammoth expansions will provide ready access to seven days of strategic storage. [SWPC]
- As Saudi loses up to 40 percent of its transmitted water daily from leaking pipes, there is great potential for a wide range of new technologies including hydro labs for local monitoring of resource. [AHK]
- Saudi Water Expo will bring these opportunities to life by connecting highlevel buyers with leading product and solution providers.
